Activities for the session 2024-25 of "Economic Society" Department of Economics G.B.Pant Memorial Govt.College Rampur Bushahr, Shimla, H.P.

"Economic Society" in the department of economics is an economic, social and cultural platform for the students of economics. The society organizes different activities specifically pertaining to the socioeconomic and cultural responsibilities of the students.
