POs	M.A. Economics Specific Outcomes
PO1	Knowledge: Giving students comprehensive, fundamental, and theoretical knowledge in the various fields of Economics and an in-depth understanding of the theoretical and empirical constructs in the field of Economics.
PO2	Critical Thinking: Prepare students to develop critical thinking and enabling them to analyse the socio-economic issues and problems; understand the events and critically investigate and evaluate objectively the public policies adopted to address these problems/events. Thus, it essentially develops cognitive skills among the students and bridges the gap between theory and practice.
PO3	Quantitative Reasoning: Students will be able to generate and interpret summary statistics and regression models; Students will be able to identify data sources, describe appropriate empirical tools, and perform research on data they retrieve from original surveys, or official and industry sources. Thus, quantitative mathematical and econometric tools will help them to understand economic problems and apply these tools and techniques to get the appropriate solutions.
PO4	Economic Citizenship: Students will be able to formulate informed opinions on policy issues and recognize the validity of opposing viewpoints by applying the acquired skills to the modelling and analysis of a wide range of theoretical and applied problems in Economics and to the understanding and solution of real world economic and social problems.
PO5	Life-long learning: Demonstrate the ability to engage in independent and life-long learning in the broadest context of socio-technological changes.
PO6	Career: Get wide range of job opportunities; ability to perform as a successful economic analyst for industry, trade and commerce, banking, and non-banking financial institutions; and acquiring knowledge, competency, and confidence to take up career in Indian Economic Service.
PO7	Competitive Edge: Attain a competitive edge in the State and Central Service examinations where the subject content of economics dominates in the selection process.
PO8	Academic Progression: The students of Economics can go for higher studies in the fields of Economics, Business Administration and Education after attaining post-graduation in economics.
PO9	Research Opportunities: completion of PG Degree in Economics with good knowledge opens up research opportunities in the national level premier Educational Institutes like IISc, IITs, Delhi School of Economics, BITs Pilani, etc.
